

The Page School Theater Workshop program is looking for 5 or 6 student interns to help with the Theater Workshop spring production for community service credit. The interns can be in grades 7-12:

The interns should be:

- Good role models
- Reliable, respectful
- They need to be available for all performances and tech rehearsals. Performances are:
  - Friday May 7<sup>th</sup> (during school – we will have to figure out if this will work)
  - Saturday May 8<sup>th</sup> at 3PM and 7PM
- Tech rehearsals are
  - Sunday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> 12 – 5
  - Monday May 3<sup>rd</sup> – Friday May 7<sup>th</sup> 3:30 – 6:30
- They need to attend a majority of the rehearsals. Rehearsals are:
  - Tuesdays and Wednesdays from January 19<sup>th</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>
  - Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from April 6<sup>th</sup> – April 30<sup>th</sup>
  - Rehearsals are 3-5PM except on early release Wednesdays when they are 1:30 – 3PM
  - Dress Rehearsal is Saturday April 10<sup>th</sup> from 12 – 5 (This is where they get their costumes fitted)
- Rehearsals (and most likely the production) are at the Page School – I am wondering if it might be possible for the interns to take a bus that goes past the school and be dropped off. This is something we can look into.

The interns will help with the following:

- Learn dances and help teach the kids
- Scene changes and movement, backstage work
- Help kids learn lines
- Snack cleanup
- Attendance
- Script doctor
- Props
- Costumes
- Makeup

Interns will not be disciplining or making decisions, this is more of a support role. They do not need to have experience.
